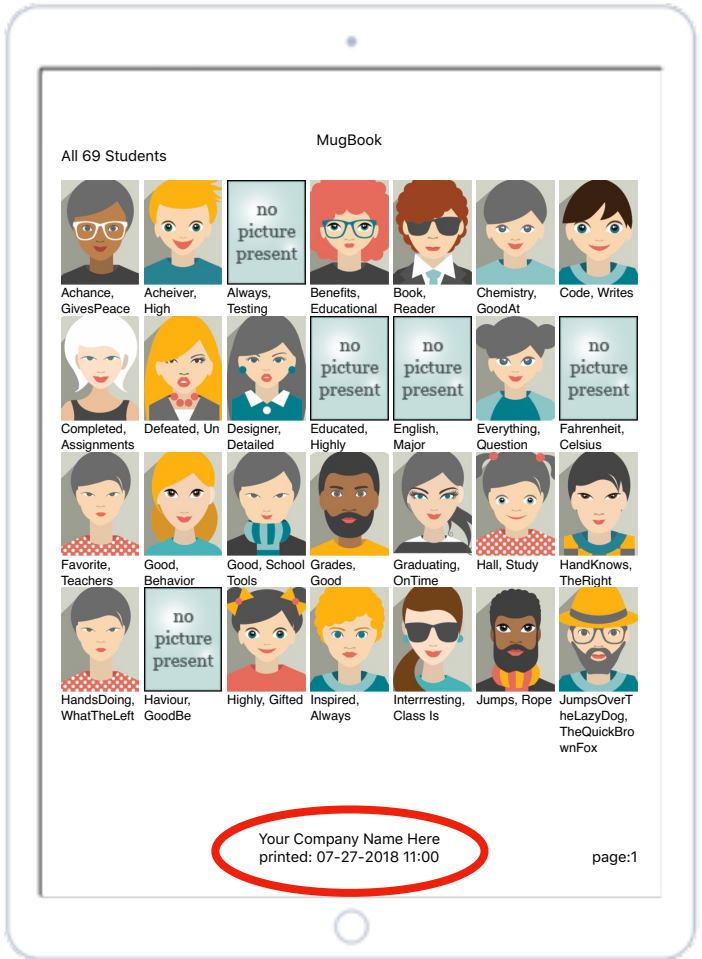

Getting Started

-Prepare Your School ID App

Select a school you will be visiting and prepare their data. You should have the list of Student Names/IDs that correspond to your photos. Save that list off as a csv file from your spreadsheet and import the roster into School ID. This is a simple copy operation using Airdrop, email or DropBox. Then import the photos using a single zip'd file of the photos for the school.

Go to your Preferences and make sure you have added in your studio's information in the "Sponsor" section at the bottom so your information will be displayed on every ID and mug book.

Now you have a fully loaded "subscriber" app that can share data with others.

*Select a designated device at the school to be the **subscriber**, & download in the App Store.*

Do an in app annual subscription in the About tab, providing your customer with an iTunes gift card.

Once the school has a subscription, load student data, photos, & preferences by exporting in the roster tab from your phone to theirs.

Making Mug Books

Use the picture tab to search for **students** using Name, DOB or a Barcode scan. Name is the default, so tap Search and type in part of first &/or last name; it's easy and responsive.



Find groups of students:

All, with or without pictures, sex, & grade. The total number of students in a group will display up top.

Use About to set up school subscriptions.
